An extraordinary Service Advisor apprentice

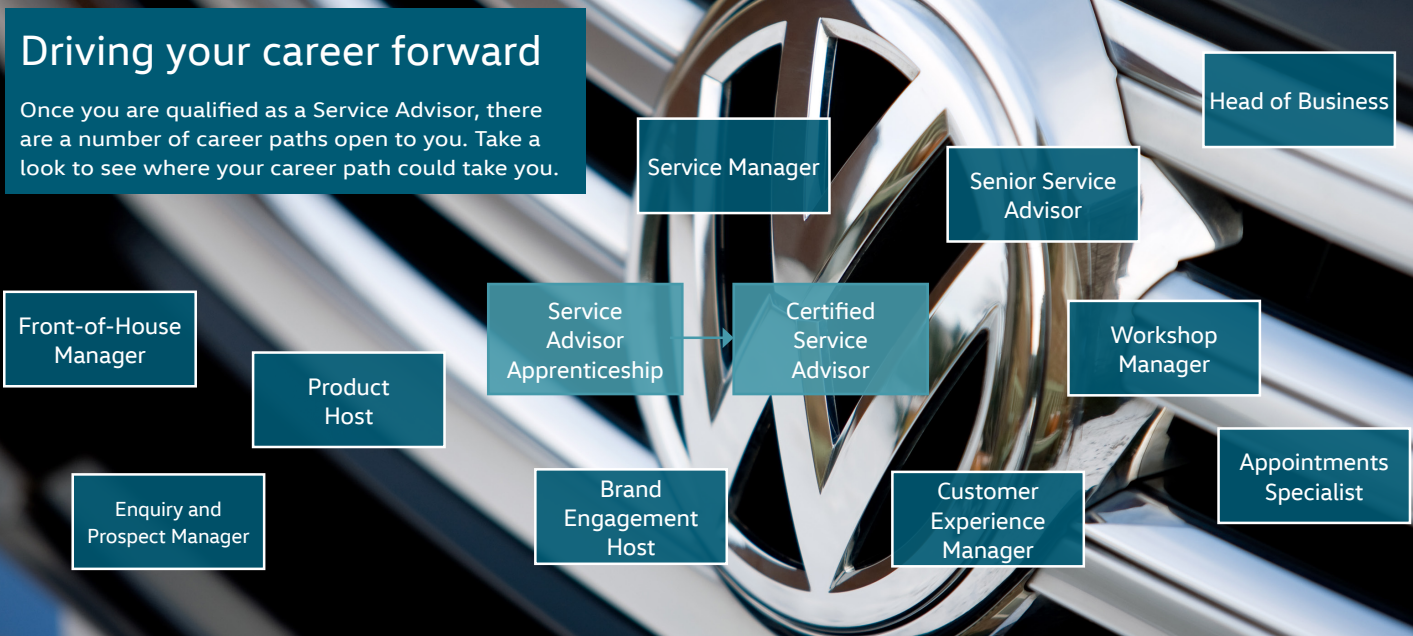
